## Payment of Fees

According to the Migration regulations of Cyprus, international students are required to be full – time (minimum 15 credits per semester). Tuition and other fees are calculated and charged at the beginning of each semester. When the Cyprus Authorities issue an entry visa, the applicant forwards the deposit of €3.000 before the visa is sent to him/her. The balance of the semester’s tuition and fees must be paid upon registration.

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: SCHOLARSHIPS

### Based on Previous Academic Performance

International students, in their first year at the College, are eligible for a scholarship on the basis of the grades of their High School Leaving Certificate, based on the country in which this qualification was issued. The eligibility for a scholarship of students who wish to transfer credits from their Bachelor’s Degree or Diploma, will be decided on the basis of those qualifications. Awards are given as a percentage reduction on the tuition.

In order to be eligible for this type of scholarship, students must:

- submit their High School Leaving Certificate and/or Bachelor’s Degree or Diploma upon application
- pay the whole semester’s tuition and fees in advance and
- have full-time status (minimum 15 credits per semester).

Generous Scholarships are also available to applicants based on financial need. For more information about scholarships please contact the Office of Admissions.

### Based on Academic Performance at Intercollege

Two regular semesters after the student first registers and every semester thereafter, scholarships will be awarded according to the student’s academic performance at Intercollege, as follows:

Cumulative GPA	Tuition Reduction
4.00	50%
3.75 – 3.99	20%
3.50 – 3.74	10%

In order to be eligible for this type of scholarship, students must have:

- full-time status,
- completed a minimum of 30 **credits** at Intercollege and
- been registered in the previous semester.

Note: Scholarship reductions are not applicable for the postgraduate programmes, other fees and Summer tuition.

## DATES TO REMEMBER

### Registration / Commencement of Classes:

Courses commence on the dates shown below, Students, however, are advised to come to Cyprus at least 1-2 weeks before registration, in order to get acquainted with Cyprus and the College, as well as to make arrangements for their accommodation, etc.
